WICHITA SCORES A HOLE-IN-ONE! **ALLEGIANT AIR ANNOUNCES NEW, NONSTOP AIR SERVICE** **BETWEEN WICHITA AND PHOENIX-MESA:**

AIRLINE CELEBRATES WITH INTRODUCTORY \$59.99* FARES

WICHITA, Kansas –Wichita, Kansas lands another hole-in-one with **Allegiant Air** as the low-cost airline today announces it will offer nonstop service to **Phoenix-Mesa** from Wichita beginning **Nov. 20**. The carrier celebrates the convenient new service to Arizona with introductory fares as low as **\$59.99*** each way.

"We are extremely pleased to again expand the Allegiant brand of low-fare, nonstop jet service in the Wichita community," Maurice J. Gallagher, Jr., president, CEO of Allegiant Air, said. "This is an exciting new addition for our airline and our customers as we link South Central Kansas with the endless sun, resorts and golf found in Arizona."

The self-proclaimed "Official Airline for Sunshine" will launch the new scheduled service from **Wichita Mid-Continent Airport** to **Phoenix-Mesa Gateway Airport** with two flights weekly on **Monday** and **Friday**. Service will begin Nov. 20 with flights departing Wichita at **12:25 p.m.** arriving in Phoenix-Mesa at **1:45 p.m.** Flights leaving Phoenix-Mesa will depart at **8:35 a.m.** arriving in Wichita at **11:45 a.m.** (all flight times are local.) Allegiant inaugurated low-cost, nonstop service to Las Vegas Feb. 27, 2003 and flights to Los Angeles May 23, 2009.

The airline commented market research and input from local community leaders indicate the Wichita community will welcome the new nonstop flights and low fares to Phoenix-Mesa. Allegiant will utilize 150-seat, MD-80 series, jet-aircraft on the route.

"We are thrilled Allegiant Air has quickly responded to our need for nonstop service to Phoenix, one of our most popular destinations," Victor White, director of airports for Wichita Mid-Continent Airport, said. "We are confident passengers will find the Phoenix-Mesa Gateway Airport convenient to use, and will love Allegiant's low fares and comfortable 150-seat MD-80 aircraft on this route. Allegiant is to be commended for recognizing our need for this service and we are particularly pleased this will be available before the holidays."



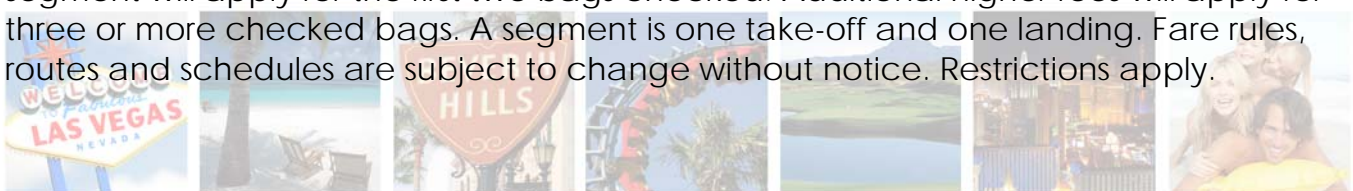

Allegiant partners with more than 40 resorts in Arizona, including hotels in the Phoenix, Scottsdale, Tempe, Mesa and Sedona and air/hotel packages are available for as low as **\$230.99***. (Price is per person, based on three-night hotel stay at the Best Western Inn of Tempe, double occupancy and reflects a Friday arrival and Monday departure. Travel must be completed by Dec. 30, 2009.) The company also provides low-cost car rental service through its partnership with **Alamo Rent a Car**.

Allegiant's **\$59.99*** one-way introductory fare is limited, must be purchased by **Oct. 21, 2009** and is valid for travel through **Feb. 10, 2010**. Introductory fares are not available on all flights. After the introductory fare period, regular one-way fares on the route start as low as **\$79.99** one-way. Reservations can be made on the airline's website at www.allegiantair.com, through the airline's Reservations and Information Center at **702-505-8888** or through professional travel agents.

About the \$59.99* one-way fare:

*Seats are limited. Fares are one-way and not available on all flights. Must be purchased by Oct. 21, 2009 for travel completed by Feb. 10, 2010. Offer not available Nov. 25-30, 2009, Dec. 22-31, 2009 and Jan. 1-4, 2010. Prices do not include PFC, segment tax or Sept. 11 security fee of up to \$10.60 per segment. A segment is one take-off and one landing. A convenience fee of \$14 per passenger will apply when booked on www.allegiantair.com. A convenience fee of \$14 per passenger, plus \$10 per segment, will apply when purchased through Allegiant Air call centers. Purchases made at any Allegiant Air Airport Ticket Office will not incur a convenience or call-center fee. When purchased at the time of booking, a first checked bag fee of \$15-\$20 per bag and second checked bag fee of \$25 will apply per person, per segment. If purchased at flight check-in, a fee of \$35 per checked bag, per person, per segment will apply for the first two bags checked. Additional higher fees will apply for three or more checked bags. A segment is one take-off and one landing. Fare rules, routes and schedules are subject to change without notice. Restrictions apply.
